On the day of the webinar, you will receive an email from Unifor's Education Department, which will provide you with a link and phone numbers to join the webinar.




The internet link is your way of joining the video meeting by computer, tablet or smart phone (more details on how to do this are below).

Unifor webinars are hosted on a platform called Webex. You can join a <u>Webex</u> video meeting using a web browser (i.e. Explorer, Safari, Firefox, Chrome)

No matter how you plan to join, you will need to have registered for it at onlineeducation.unifor.org so that the Education department can send you the email invitation.

How to join a Webex meeting using a web browser

- 1. Open the meeting invitation in your email and click "Join."
- 2. Click "Join from your browser."





- **3.** On the Webex meeting window, configure the audio and video for the meeting. You can choose whether to use your computer's audio, dial in with your phone to establish the audio for the meeting.
- **4.** You can also show or hide video.
- 5. When you're ready, click "Join Meeting."

How to join a Webex meeting using a mobile app

You can join a Webex meeting from your iPhone, iPad, or Android device. Before you get started, install the Webex app for iOS (find this at the App Store on Apple devices) or the Webex app for Android (find this at the Google Play store).

- **1.** Open the meeting invitation in your email app and click "Join." The Webex app will start automatically.
- 2. In the Webex app, you will choose whether to show or hide your video.
- 3. When you're ready, tap "Join."

How to join a webex meeting by phone:

- 1. The invitation email also contains call-in numbers. You will see a list of local numbers for locations across Canada.
- 2. Select your city, dial the number and enter the access code provided.
