Unifor's 2026 Canadian Council 2026 committed to intensifying the fight to protect Canadian jobs with delegates rallying on Parliament Hill.

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Members at General Motors voted overwhelmingly to ratify agreements that deliver new products and investment, and strong pattern wage and benefit gains.

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Unifor opened negotiations with Stellantis with a clear focus to secure good jobs and position more than 9,000 members for a strong future.

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Unifor calls on Quebec government to prioritize PACCAR in awarding of public procurement contract.

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Unifor welcomes the CRTC's move to ensure Canadian programming is visible on streaming services, while urging the federal government to quickly implement contribution requirements for digital streamers.
