This month, we've witnessed unjust tariffs, including the recently announced auto tariffs imposed by Donald Trump, taking effect. The immediate impacts are already being felt, with thousands of Unifor members facing layoffs. **This is a fight for every Canadian worker** as these tariffs threaten jobs across all sectors and industries.

It's time to work together to protect Canadian jobs.

On **Saturday, April 26, 2025, at 1:00 p.m. E.T.**, we will be holding a [Protect Canadian Jobs](#) rally in Windsor to make our voices heard and to show that all workers, regardless of industry, stand united in this fight.

Bus transportation will be coordinated from multiple locations, including Brampton, Oshawa, Toronto, Kitchener, and other surrounding areas. **Local unions must [pre-register](#) their members to ensure a spot on the bus.** Lunch will be provided on the bus, and all buses will return to their departure locations on the same day.
